


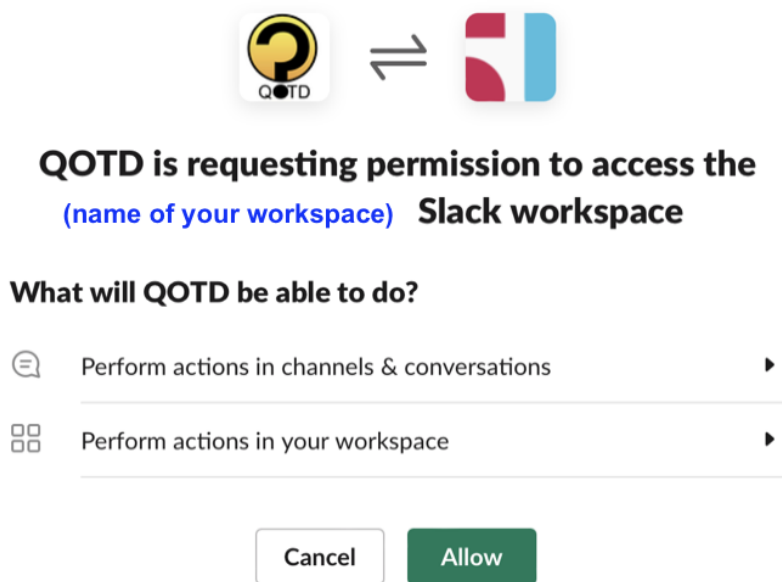
# INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING QOTD

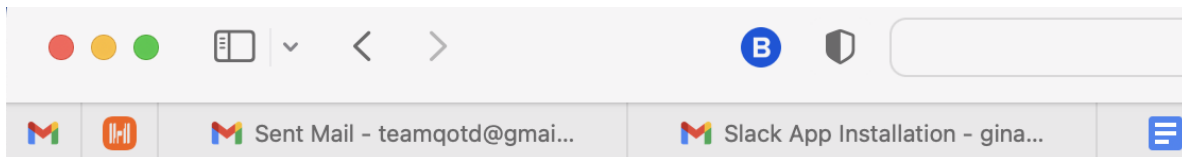
From the Slack App Store or the Question of the day website, click on the  button.

You will see the following message requesting permission to access your Slack workspace. Click to 'Allow'.

Example:

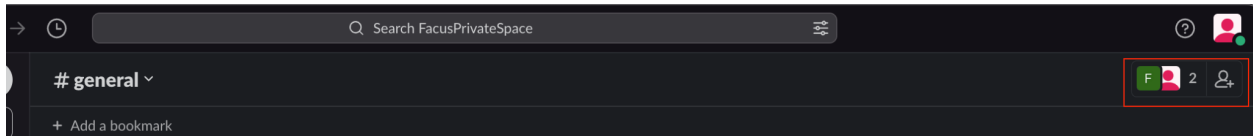


After you have clicked on allow, you will receive a message that the Question of the Day app has been successfully installed.

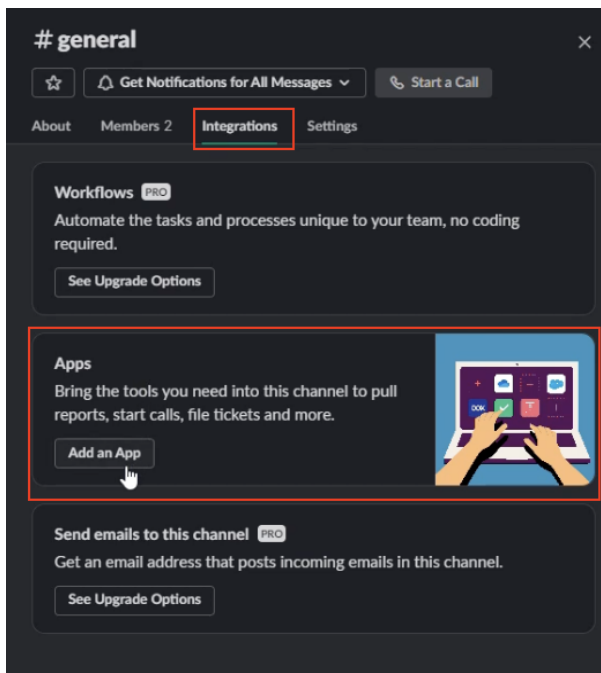


**Question of the day APP was installed in your space! You can go ahead and use it!**

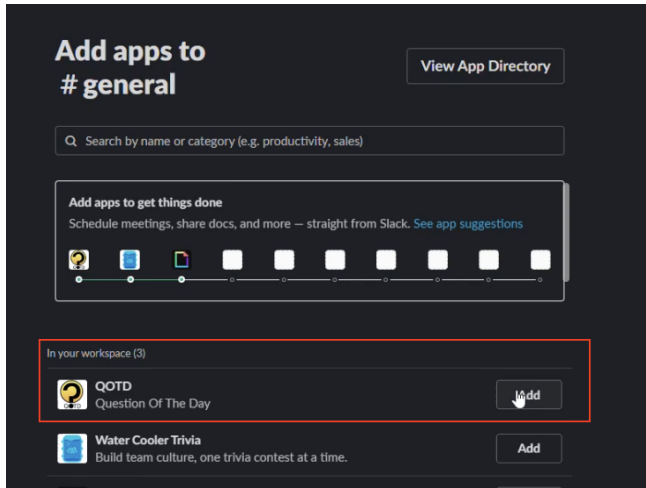
Pull up your Slack. Click on the channel in which you would like to use QOTD. Once in the channel, in the top right hand corner of the screen click on the icons that show all of the team members in your channel.



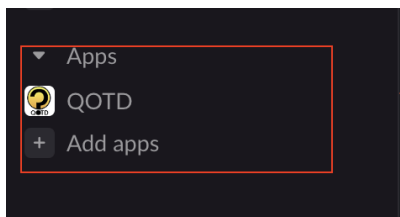
You will see a modal appear. In the top menu bar of the modal, click on **Integrations**. Once you have clicked on integrations you will see a section for **Apps**, click to 'Add an App'.



Now that you have selected to add an app you should see QOTD as an app on the top of your list. Select QOTD and click to 'Add'.



You should see a message appear in your channel indicating that QOTD has been added. In the bottom left hand corner of your Slack screen, under the **App** section, you should also see the QOTD app listed there.



Now that QOTD has been officially integrated with your Slack space, in your chosen channel, use the command `/qotd` to generate a question, send it to your team, and start the conversation! Enjoy!
